Recently, the Union Negotiating Committee and Company representatives met with Federal Mediation and Conciliation Services (FMCS) Commissioner, Andrew Hall. The parties had brief interaction, through the mediator, and, ultimately, adjourned, with the understanding the Company was to respond to the Union and present a proposal covering all issues.

Federal Mediator Andy Hall notified the parties of his departure from FMCS; and, the parties are awaiting the assignment of a new FMCS Commissioner. The Union has communicated their interest in having the case assigned to the Local FMCS's most experienced Commissioner.

Additional bargaining dates have not yet been scheduled; however, upon receipt of the Company's anticipated communication to the Union, dates will be scheduled accordingly.

We appreciate your continued support, cooperation and solidarity through this very difficult process.
